ii. **Distinctions achieved by students in co-curricular activities such as :-** **ACADEMIC AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES:**

Our students have brought laurels to the institution by participating in several cultural activities.

- Shalini Guleria and Arti of B.Com 3rd won the First Prize in Quiz Competition at District Level at GDC Dehri on 29-11-21. Then they also won the First Prize in the Quiz Competition in Zonal Level at GDC Dharamshala on 06-12-21. Both competitions were organized by Department of Excise and Taxation (Govt. of HP) under “AZADI KA AMRIT MOHOTSAV CAMPAIGN”
- Two days Talent Hunt Competition was held in the college under “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav” campaign on 22nd and 23rd November, 2021 in order to nurture the talent of the students and to promote their creativity, enthusiasm, innovation for overall development of the students. Huge participation from students was there to showcase their talents in different fields.
- College level activities were organized by the cultural committee on Mehendi Design, Rangoli Making, Group and Solo Dance, Solo and Group Singing, Poster making etc. The theme of the event was **SACRIFICIES MADE BY FREEDOM FIGHTERS IN INDIA**. This was an area where students strived hard to acclaim proficiency in the field of arts including the following events: Poster making, Slogan writing, Spot painting, Mehendi, Rangoli, Clay modeling, Collage making and Spot photography.
- On 31st December 2021, an Awareness Campaign (Rally) on “Road Safety” was organised by the Road Safety Club in association with NSS Unit, Rover and Ranger Unit, Eco Club, Red Ribbon Club and Youth Red club of Govt. Degree College Nagrota Surian. Students of the college along with all the staff members participated in the campaign which started from the college campus and concluded at the bus stand of Nagrota Surian town. The rally was organised to raise awareness among the students of the college and general public.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME:

The prime objective of NSS is to evolve the multi-dimensional personality and develop the spirit of community service, social consciousness and social responsibility among students to serve the community. Presently the college has a half-unit of NSS that comprises 50 students, Asst. Prof. Monika Sharma is Unit In-Charge of the college. The following activities were organized during the session:

Various activities under the aegis of "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav", "Samajik Chetna Abhiyan" and "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan" were organized wef 11 August 2021 to 9 December 2021. All other units/clubs of the college also collaborated in these activities. The NSS volunteers kept themselves engaged throughout the year in the accomplishment of various tasks related to beautification, cleanliness, awareness and plantation drives under the aegis of “Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav”.

Seven days Special camp was organized in the college from 7 March to 14th March, 2022, where the main focus was laid upon the cleanliness, beautification, and preparation of the ground of the new college campus. Various guest lectures on the topic of Women Empowerment, Religion and philosophy, Road safety, Financial Literacy, Personality Development and positive approach in student life were held to educate and encourage the volunteers about various aspects of life. Volunteers visited the houses in the adopted village Bantungali and gathered information regarding various Government-sponsored schemes for the rural areas. NSS volunteers Nitin Sharma among Boys and Vanshika Guleria among Girls has been adjudged as the best NSS volunteers for session 2021-22.

ROVERS AND RANGERS:

The Rovers and Rangers unit was established in July 2021. The unit is in the early stages of development however it has been actively involved in various co-curricular activities along with NSS, Youth Red Club, Eco club, Red Ribbon Club and Road Safety Club of the college. Mr. Parveer Dhiman is the Rover-Leader and Ms. Neha Dewan is the Ranger-Leader of the unit.

ROAD SAFETY CLUB:

Road Safety Club has been established in the college with effect from October 2021. The club is actively engaged in carrying out campaigns and competitions to raise awareness about road safety among the students of the college as well as the public at large.

1. On 31st December 2021 road safety club organised an awareness campaign (rally) that was taken out from the college premises up to the local bus Stand.
2. Road Safety Club also organised online competitions in online mode viz. Poster Making, Slogan Writing on 7 January 2022.
3. A special lecture by DSP Jawali was organised by the Road Safety Club to raise awareness on road safety on 10 March 2022. Also on this day six competitions were organised by the club.

ECO CLUB:

In view of the growing environmental awareness, various competitions like were organized on the "World Environment Day" along with NSS, Rovers and Rangers, Youth Red Club. World Ozone Day was celebrated on 16 September 2022. Various competitions viz. Slogan Writing, Poster Making and Painting were organized on Wild Life and Forest Conservation on 10 March 2022.

RED RIBBON CLUB:

As per the directions of H.P AIDS Control Society a unit of 'Red Ribbon Club' was formed in the college in 2015, since then it became an instrument in spreading awareness about various blood related diseases. Under "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav" the Red Ribbon Club organized various competitions such as Poster Making, One minute video on blood Donation and TB were conducted by the club from 12 to 20 August 2021. World Ozone day was also celebrated in the college by the club. A Poster-Making competition on the topic of 'Causes of HIV infection' was organized on 29 December 2021.

SPORTS:

In the current academic session the sports men and women exhibited their sportsmanship by participating and winning various competitions in the 'Sports Events' held from 24-11-21 to 27-11-21 and 'Annual Athletic Meet' of the college held on 27-12-2021 . Abhishek Patial among boys and Kajal among girls were declared as the best athletes.

CAREER GUIDANCE & COUNSELING CELL:

A scholarship/placement workshop was organized for the students by HCL Technologies to induct students in their Tech-Bee Program on 15 November 2021. During the year 2021-22, the cell organized Special Workshop on personality development, communication skills and job avenues. Mr. Naresh Sharma, District Youth Officer Nehru Youth Centre and Dr. Chaman Professor of Management (KV Dharamshala) delivered lectures to final year students of the college on 5 March 2022.

SWACHCH BHARAT ABHIYAN & FIT INDIA PLOGGING RUN DRIVE:

On 02nd October 2022, students and staff actively participated in Swachah Bharat Abhiyan & Fit India Plogging Run. Principal, students and staff not only cleaned the campus but also the area around the campus. A huge rally from college campus to Bantungli Aayurvedic hospital was organized by NSS, ECO-CLUB, ROAD SAFETY CLUB, YOUTH RED CLUB, RED RIBBON CLUB and ROVER & RANGER unit in order to educate the general public about fitness, hygiene and cleanliness.

ANTI-RAGGING & DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE:

Anti-Ragging cell was formed in the college for the session of 2021-22. Prof. Monika Sharma, Prof. Anuragini and Prof. Vijay Kumar are the members of this committee.

WOMEN REDRESSAL CELL:

To ensure Gender equality and Gender Justice the college has an active Women Redressal Cell convened by Prof. Monika Sharma. The cell provides platform for listening to the various complaints related sexual harassment of girls & female employees. The objective

of this cell is to address women grievances to sensitize them and also to make them aware of their rights. The cell also organizes a lecture on 21st October, 2021 on the importance of 'Health and Hygiene' by Prof. Monika, Prof. Anuragini and Prof. Neha Dewan and Prof. Manu Priya.

- Canteen furniture provided in campus canteen.

- Students are encouraged to participate in various competitions at college as well as university level.
- Students actively participate in extracurricular and co-curricular activities such as Hindi Diwas, Teachers Day, No-Tabaco Day, AIDS Day, World Environment Day, Cultural Function, Plantation drives, Quiz Competitions, debate and discussions through online mode.
- 43 students verified at intuition level for various scholarship schemes.
- Career, Guidance and counseling and Grievances Redressal Cell are functioning in the college.
- Women harassment cell is also functioning very effectively.
- Discipline and Anti-Ragging Committee ensures that no untoward incidents occur in the college campus during working hours.

(f) **Governance, Leadership & Management.**

- Staff members were engaged to manage the Vaccination Drive organized for the vaccination of college students before examination by health department.
- Various committees are formed by the Principal to promote a culture of participative management.
- Faculty members participated in conferences and act as resource person the different events organized by various institutions.

(g) **Innovative Practices.**

- Regular sanitization of the entire campus carried out on fluently basis by college administration.
- Counseling and awareness among students about Covid-19 pandemic for safety purposes and to follow the SOP as per the direction by higher authority.
- Plantation Drive was organized at the site of the new college building by different Clubs and college Students.
